## Tax Updates

#### U.S. Companies only

The release includes these important tax compliance updates.

- The Section 179 expense deduction increased \$20,000 to a maximum of \$1,040,000 for tax years beginning in 2020. You can use the Tax Expense report to check how much Section 179 you have claimed across all assets in a tax year.
- The Section 179 expense deduction for Sports Utility Vehicles (SUVs) increased to a maximum of \$25,900 for tax years beginning in 2020.
- Automobiles (property type A) and Light Trucks and Vans (property type T) depreciation caps remain the same in 2020 as in 2019.
- Form 4562 is updated to generate the 2019 Form 4562–Depreciation and Amortization.
- Tax extenders from the Further Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2020. The act extended the following through 12/31/2020:
  - Enterprise Zone designation for tax incentives, including increased Section 179 expensing.

- o Section 168 first-year 50% allowance for second Generation Biofuel Plant property.
- Shorter recovery life of 3-years for certain Racehorses.
- o Shorter recovery life of 7-years for Motorsports Entertainment Complexes.
- Shorter recovery lives for Indian Reservation property.

#### Canadian Companies only

Two new classes, 54 and 55 for zero-emission vehicles, have been added to the list of capital cost allowances.

## Improved file naming for saved reports

In today's world, most reports are saved to a file for future reference instead of printed and kept in a binder. If the same reports are run on a regular basis for different companies and saved to a common folder, it is impossible to differentiate between reports without opening and renaming it. Now reports have an enhanced naming convention that adds the depreciation book title and the period for which the report was run, if applicable. The enhanced naming applies to reports saved to file in Batch Reporting and Global Task Manager.

## **Fixes**

With this release, Sage made the following fixes to the indicated Sage Fixed Assets products. Fixes with no specific product notation apply to all products that include the feature.

## 168 Bonus amount in Beginning Accum field issue - 4797 treatment

When the Beginning Accum amount is overstated or includes accelerated (first year bonus) depreciation, the Form 4797 Part III for Section 1250 property did not calculate ordinary gain correctly. This is now fixed.

# Asset with bonus method, Section 179 and decreased business use % calculates incorrectly

Fixed an issue where depreciation calculates incorrectly for an asset in the year the Business Use % is changed. This happens for an asset that has both a bonus method and Section 179 amount when the Business Use % is high (90% - 100%) in the place-in-service year and then lower in a later year.

### Bulk Edit freezes on validate in Citrix environment

Sage Fixed Assets—Depreciation (Premier, Network, and Standard – U.S. Companies only)

Fixed an issue where Bulk Edit freezes during the validation step when using a Citrix environment.

## Temp file message on prepare and receive of scanner

Fixed an issue where a temp file message displays in Tracking when preparing a reader and receiving data from a reader.

# Custom Import - RV Override fields incorrectly display for an 'Update Asset' import

Fixed an issue where Replacement Value (RV) Override fields are available when completing an 'Update Asset' custom import.

### Find - Unable to display results message

'Find' will no longer display an "Unable to Display Results" message when searching on a group that contains more than 200 assets.

## Blank Asset List when doing a Restore Company

Sage Fixed Assets Premier—Depreciation

Fixed an issue where restoring a company occasionally results in a blank Asset List.

## Newly added SmartList entry incorrectly prompting to Keep/Blank on delete

When deleting a SmartList entry that is not currently being used for any assets, the system will no longer prompt the user to 'Keep the Original Entry' or 'Blank the Original Entry'.

## Arrow keys move the focus to next field when editing book information

Fixed an issue where using the arrow keys while editing critical fields moves the cursor to the next field instead of within the current field.

## Planning integration to Depreciation: Error - Not all assets created

Fixed an issue when creating multiple assets in Depreciation from a single line item in Planning. The issue occurred when the Planning line item contained both negative and positive transaction amounts.

## 199A Report showing Activity Code J (partial disposal, original portion) assets

Sage Fixed Assets (Premier, Network, and Standard – U.S. Companies only)

Fixed an issue where the Section 199A Report overstates some assets' acquired value due to the original portion of a partial disposal being incorrectly included in the report. This happens when depreciation and the report is run for a year prior to the date of the partial disposal.

## 199A Report may hang when Depr Method is NO and Life is 0 years

Fixed a rare issue where the Section 199A Report may hang when assets with Depreciation Method of NO and Estimated Life of 0 are included in the report.

## **Known Issues**

## **Crystal Reports compatibility**

Sage Fixed Assets 2018.1 through 2020.1 uses SAP Crystal Reports runtime SP21. This may cause an issue with older Crystal Reports runtime versions used by other products.

You may experience a compatibility issue after upgrading to Sage Fixed Assets 2020.1 if you are also using Sage 100 (2017 and earlier), Sage 300 (2018.x and earlier), Sage 300 CRE (v18.1 and earlier), or Sage 500 (2018 and earlier).
